





HICKORY COUNTY COMMISSION
MEETING OF MAY 2, 2024
MINUTES

1. The meeting of May 2, 2024, was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Presiding Commissioner Sawyer. Present were Commissioner Pearson, Commissioner Breshears, Treasurer Kenny Ratliff, Sue Dorman, Dawn Vader, Sherrie Close, and County Clerk Tamara Weidman. Upon a motion made by Commissioner Pearson and a second by Commissioner Breshears the minutes of the Meeting of April 29, 2024, were approved as presented. 3-0 vote
2. The Commission met with Dawn Vader of Hickory County Health Department and Sherrie Close of Compass Health Network which serves a 7 County area including Hickory County. Sherrie is a Community Health Liaison that works directly with law enforcement when they must handle individuals with mental disorders. She explained the Governor is requiring interactive workshops, called Sequential Intercept Model (SIM), consisting of stakeholders, peers and decision makers in the County to determine areas of need within the County. The workshop is scheduled for September 12th and 13th of 2024. A planning meeting to determine the stakeholders, peers and decision makers will be held on May 28th at 10:00 a.m. at the Hickory County Health Department. The hope is to relieve the burden on law enforcement by rehabilitation efforts for individuals with mental health issues.


HICKORY COUNTY COMMISSION
